**24<sup>th</sup> June 2009 Ajantha Mendis** signs for South Australia for the 20-20.

**10<sup>th</sup> August 2009 Ajantha Mendis** signs for Hampshire CC for county cricket for the 2010 season.

A right-arm, slow-medium bowler, Ajantha Mendis is a spinner who bowls a mixture of googlies, off breaks, top-spinners, flippers and leg breaks. Mendis was called up to the Sri Lanka squad for the tour of West Indies in April 2008.

**26<sup>th</sup> June 2009 Tilakaratne Dilshan** signs for Northern Districts for the 20-20.

Tillakaratne Dilshan burst onto to the international scene with an unbeaten 163 against Zimbabwe in his first series during November 1999. Technically sound, comfortable against fast bowling, possessed of quick feet, strong wrists and natural timing, Dilshan has talent in abundance. During the 2009 ICC World Twenty20, he created the game's latest invention with an astonishing flick-shot over his head which became the talk of the cricket world; he also picked up the Player-of-the-Series award after amassing 317 runs at an average of 52.83.

**1<sup>st</sup> August 2009 Rangana Herath** signs for Surrey CC for county cricket for the 2009 season.

Rangana shot to prominence against Australia in 1999. An orthodox left-arm spinner who regularly played for the Sri Lankan A team, before being recalled for the third Test against Australia in Colombo. He is fast shaping into a potent partner for Muttiah Muralitharan.

**6<sup>th</sup> October 2009 Shakib Al Hasan** signs for Wocestershire CC for county cricket for 2010

Shakib Al Hasan is a left-arm spinner and talented batsman, who ensured his place in the Bangladesh squad for the U-19 World Cup in Sri Lanka with a blistering performance in the final of the tri-nations U-19 ODI tournament in Bangladesh.

His best moment in the Test arena came when he led Bangladesh to their first-ever overseas Test series win against a second-string West Indies. Standing in for the injured captain Mashrafe Mortaza, Shakib and he picked up the Man-of-the-Series prize for his 13 wickets

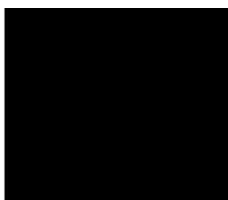
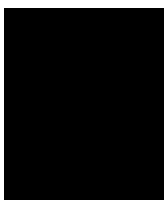

A right-arm seamer, Tissara Perera opened the bowling for the U-19s and turned in noteworthy performances in the tri-nation tournament in Sri Lanka in July 2007 and in the youth Test against India in Colombo the following month. Those performances earned him a call-up to the U-19 squad for the World Cup in Malaysia in 2008. He received his maiden national call-up during Sri Lanka's tour of India in 2009 as an emergency replacement for Angelo Mathews. His ambition is to remain associated with the game by taking up coaching.
